The masked folk hero Santo (b. 1917; real name Rodolfo Guzmán Huerta, but **nobody** knows this) had just begun what would have been a long and illustrious career as a *luchador* when the Serpentfall hit. Santo rapidly fell afoul of the Almazan regime, once it overthrew the Mexican government: he has spent the last few years throwing the Sinarquistas out of southern Mexico, one fascist at a time. He is loved by the common folk. He is feared by every corrupt official from Tijuana to Tapachula. The Sinarquistas are torn between hating him for his defiance, and desiring to convert him to their cause.

He is Santo.

Attributes: Agility d10, Smarts d8, Spirit d8, Strength d10, Vigor d8

Skills: Fighting d10, Guts d6, Intimidation d6, Investigation d6, Notice d6, Persuasion d6, Stealth d6, Streetwise d4, Taunt d6

Charisma: 2 **Pace:** 6 **Parry:** 8 **Toughness:** 7

Edges: Charismatic, Combat Reflexes, Command, Danger Sense, Improved Block, Improved Dodge, Improved Martial Arts Training, Improved Sweep

Hindrances: Heroic (Major), Enemy (Minor), Wanted (Minor)

Gear: Santo typically wears a silver luchador mask and matching silver tights. Sometimes he adds a cape. If he ever needs more equipment, he will acquire it.

Note: The Enemy and Wanted are both Minor because while the Mexican government would *accept* Santo's death, it would much rather recruit him.
